President Omar Hassan al-Bashir said he would not grant visas to a <u>United Nations</u> human rights team that wants to visit the western region. Speaking in Cannes, France, where he was attending an annual France-Africa summit meeting, Mr. Bashir said, "There are members of that delegation who, in our view, are not impartial." On Thursday, Secretary General <u>Ban Ki-moon</u> said Mr. Bashir of <u>Sudan</u> had broken a personal pledge to give entry permits to United Nations rights monitors and urged him to reconsider.
