MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Decisions Reached at Meeting of Director
of Central Intelligence with CIG Council


At today's meeting with the CIG Council, the Director of Central Intelligence made the following decisions:

- a. That the Council should review all papers prior to submission to the Director, with a view to insuring that they are consistent with established or recommended CIG policy. If it is agreed that a paper should be rewritten, it will be returned to the drafting agency for revision.
- b. That the Secretary, NIA, will notify the Council each day of all projects initiated the previous day. Discussion of such projects is not precluded, but definite decisions by the Council will normally await consideration of the recommendations prepared by the CIG unit to which the paper was referred.
- c. That, as soon as practicable, the Central Planning Staff should undertake, as a matter of priority, a study of the coordination of intelligence research, with particular reference to recommending what form of research and analysis unit should be organized in the Central Intelligence Group.
- d. That future draft CIG directives initiating studies or surveys will be considered by the Council, who will recommend action to the Director. If approved by the Director, the directive will normally be issued immediately, with copies to the IAB for information only rather than consideration as in previous cases.
