The NBC is planning a series of 40 television broadcasts on American Intelligence and objectives. Mr. Jackson will call Mr. Trammell of NBC to find out what it's all about.

Mr. Jackson said he would like to review the instructions which have been prepared for Senior Representatives abroad.

Mr. [REDACTED] will ask Mr. Carey to prepare requirements for [REDACTED]. Dr. Langer will be asked to review these requirements.

Mr. O'Gara reported that he had recommended to AD/SO that O/SO administration be organized. He will discuss similar plans with Mr. Wisner and says that each office will be organized along similar lines but independently, and that a combination of the administrative offices could occur later.

Mr. [REDACTED] asked if retired officers could be employed without compensation. Mr. Jackson said that this was permissible, but suggested clearing with the Director's office in each instance.

Mr. [REDACTED] reported that the Air Force had requested [REDACTED] release for an important assignment but that NIS was opposed to releasing him. Mr. Jackson said that he should be released because of what the Air Force is doing for us service-wise.

Mr. Jackson asked whether the orders had been issued yet that no personal mail will be opened by the Mail Room. He was told that they have been.

Mr. Reber asked whether he could give CIA Regulation 70 to other organizations. It was decided that it was premature to do this.
