Daily Staff Meeting

Tuesday, 13 February 1951

Mr. Dulles reported that he and Mr. Wisner briefed Deputy Chief of Staff, General Maxwell Taylor, on OPC operations in the Far East [redacted]

Mr. [redacted] said that both Admiral Stevens and General Magruder had objected to the use in a covert capacity of out-of-uniform regular army or navy officers.

Mr. Kirkpatrick asked Mr. Reber to set up a conference with OIR on requirements and to get the branch chiefs of [redacted] to participate.

Mr. [redacted] reported that there had been extensive conversations on International Communism and that OSO was extremely anxious that someone assume full responsibility for it. Mr. Reber is to review the situation with State and to come up with recommendations for the Director to submit to IAC.
