Mr. [] said that CIA had approximately 200 employees who were eligible for the draft, and that it would probably lose all of those in departmental positions and be able to have deferred those in overseas jobs. As far as personnel procurement is concerned, he stated that efforts were being made to procure only persons who are not eligible for the draft.

Mr. McConnell said that he had called Mrs. Rosenberg inasmuch as Mr. Jackson had been unable to reach her yesterday.

Mr. Kirkpatrick reported on the proposed statement that HICOG was to issue on granting asylum to defectors. Mr. Dulles suggested this be referred to O/PC for comment.

Mr. Dulles instructed Mr. O'Gara to send the paper on training to O/SO and O/PC for comment prior to issuance.
