


Daily Staff Meeting

Tuesday, 1 May 1951

[redacted] reported that Mr. Webb was anxious to convene a meeting of the Psychological Strategy Board and had asked whether General Smith would be available today.

Mr. Reber raised the question as to whether the Director wished requirements to be discussed by the IAC on Thursday. He was informed that the Director's views appeared to be that a thorough study should be made prior to discussion by the IAC.

[redacted] said that he had instructed Mr. Pforzheimer to press the matter of drafting legislation for a CIA career service. In addition, he had asked him to prepare a report on the CIA legislative program.

Mr. Hunt reported the case where one potential recruit, a Princeton senior, had been approached by six CIA Personnel people.
