Director's Meeting

Monday, 28 May 1951

The Director asked whether there had been any report from [redacted] and was informed that no decision had been reached as yet. He said he would call [redacted] HR70-14

There was discussion of the radio broadcast of Secretary of State Acheson to the people of Georgia and whether this had been properly coordinated with the Psychological Strategy Board.

Mr. Jackson reported that there would be a meeting on 28 May with the NSC Special Committee on O/PC magnitude. The Director stated that the CIA position should be to get rid of as much as we could.

Mr. Dulles reported that he was looking into the qualifications of [redacted] and of [redacted] who previously had been associated with Sikorsky Aviation.
