Mr. Wolf raised the matter of the best method of implementing the [] project for the purchase of cryptographic equipment. He said that he would consult with [] O/CI, and attempt to work out the best corporate set-up.

Mr. Dulles asked that somebody be instructed to review the MacArthur hearings and extract all items concerning CIA or intelligence. (Mr. Pforzheimer has been doing this during the course of the hearings and will prepare a final report.)

There was discussion of the operations of the Projects Review Committee and it was decided that the Assistant Directors of the operating offices should be allowed to approve of projects on their own involving amounts not exceeding \$10,000 and that O/SO and O/PC should be given \$100,000 each for this purpose and O/O \$50,000.

There was discussion of the problem of inducing the defection of East German scientists and technicians. It was decided that there was need for additional study of this matter and an analysis should be made to determine whether our facilities in the Defector Reception Center could handle additional persons.

Mr. Dulles stated that he believed Colonel [] currently in the process of training, would be an ideal Senior Representative in []. He was formerly head of [] in Latin America. Mr. Dulles will get biographical information on King to submit to the other Deputies and the Director.
