Mr. Dulles said that Assistant Secretary McGhee had certain questions on the proposed cable to [redacted]. The Director talked to McGhee and then to Acheson and it was agreed that he would take up the matter with the President.

Mr. Jackson reported that he had talked to Tracy Barnes and that he thought Mr. Lovett should be called with the request that he talk to [redacted]

Mr. Kirkpatrick reported that the State Department was making attempts to have [redacted] an O/RR man with the Food Mission in Yugoslavia, stay on beyond the agreed time and that Millikan had turned them down.

Mr. Kirkpatrick reported that Gen. Partridge, who is to succeed Gen. Megée on the Joint Staff, would be in CIA to be briefed.

Mr. Jackson raised the question as to whether Justice Douglas should be briefed prior to his trip to Afghanistan.
