Called Mr. Clark, OSI, in regard to the semi-annual report to the Joint Congressional Committee on Atomic Energy. He stated that the paper should be ready Thursday morning and that there probably would be a Navy dissent.

Mr. Clark called in regard to the Communications Advisor to the President. He saw Mr. Finan of the Bureau of the Budget today and believes that Finan agrees with him that the Advisor should be a man of ability and firmness and not merely a coordinator. Finan stated that he believed it was too late to speak to Mr. Lawton as the matter was now at the appointment stage at the White House.

Talked to [redacted] Contact Branch, and told him that Jimmy Lay's office had requested a short memorandum on United Service to China by Thursday morning to be transmitted to the President.

After talking with Mr. Pforzheimer, set up a Loyalty Board meeting for 3:30 on Thursday in the conference room.

Find that Col. Vandervoort is going to [redacted].  
Advised the DCI of this as he was anxious to know of any CIA personnel going to [redacted].

Kirkpatrick called to say that they wanted to use [redacted].
