The Director asked Mr. Dulles to see that is spoken to about the proposed LOOK article. It should be pointed out that such an article is against U.S. interests, and should not appear in LOOK or any other form. Mr. Dulles reported on the possibility of furnishing help to the

The Director believes that Col. Baird's book on Career Training is a good job furnishing an excellent initial plan. He feels that Mr. Trubee Davison and Mr. Dulles should read it carefully.

Mr. Dulles reported on the letter setting forth an invitation from SHAPE on CE activities in wartime. submitted a draft cable reply for us to clear. DCI okayed the cable.

Mr. Dulles wants to close out the accounting on projects of which there are about 22 either dead or dying. These projects should be cancelled as of June 30, 1951. We will have to accept less definite receipts than we would wish. The DCI agreed.

Mr. Dulles will take in to see the Director this afternoon sometime after 4 o'clock.

Mr. Dulles will see and Gen. Donovan in New York tomorrow.

The Director stated that he was very anxious to have a competent man take over the net. Suggested that it might be well to send Willoughby over for a while.
