


Official Diary

Thursday, 6 September 1951

Confirmed with Mr. Dines that the DCI had approved a survey by AD/IC covering exchange of intelligence and intelligence information with foreign nations. Advised Mr. Dines of the DCI's direction that no arrangements for such exchange be made other than under guidance of the Office of the DCI.



Discussed with [redacted] of O/CI the paper being prepared by the ADHOC Committee of SECOP of USCIB and expressed the view that I would support the original minority report of the Committee as against the compromise draft prepared by Packard of State, unless very substantial changes were made in Packard's paper to bring it more into line with the minority report. [redacted] undertook to take this position in Committee.
