## Director's Meeting

Wednesday, 12 September 1951

PRESENT: Messrs. Dulles, Jackson, Wisner, Wolf, Becker.

Mr. Becker reported that Gordon Dean, Chairman of the Atomic Energy Commission, in conversation with Dr. Chadwell, OSI, had expressed regret that CIA had not assisted AEC in securing an amendment of the AEC Act with respect to the type of information [redacted] Dr. Chadwell had indicated that this was due to the situation existing at that time (when the amendment was proposed) and that CIA would probably give such assistance at some later date. Mr. Becker undertook to inform the DCI on this.

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Mr. Dulles noted the log item respecting the [redacted] summary being forwarded to SHAPE, and Mr. Wisner undertook to review this for some brief time.

Mr. Dulles stated that he had a memorandum respecting the [redacted] operation and handed such memorandum to Mr. Becker for the DCI.

At the request of Mr. Dulles, Mr. Becker undertook to ascertain the position of CIA with respect to the so-called [redacted] for the information of the DCI and the D/DCI. Mr. Wisner suggested that the attention of the NSC should be called to the necessity for a policy decision in the event that [redacted]

Mr. Dulles raised the question as to the adequacy of the courier service, and Mr. Wolf undertook to look into this question.


Mr. Wisner gave to Mr. Becker for transmittal to the DCI a memorandum respecting [redacted] and inquired when the Director could see [redacted]

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


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Mr. Wolf reported that General Davison was consulting with Dr. Langer to arrange for overseas assignments for ONE personnel. Mr. Wisner emphasized that such personnel, before going abroad, should be thoroughly briefed by [ ] so that they would not attempt to get involved in operations.



Mr. Wolf raised the question of the status of Gen. McClellan who is joining the Agency as Director of Communications with rank of AD. Mr. Dulles authorized Mr. Wolf to give General McClellan a [ ] if that seemed reasonable after his discussion with General McClellan.

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
