



Wednesday, 10 October 1951

Conference with Mr. Shannon, Pforzheimer and Col. Hansen about steps to be taken in regard to our building when the appropriations bill hits the Senate and the Conference Committee.



Called [redacted] Comptroller's Office, about project [redacted]. In accordance with Mr. Dulles' instruction, accountability will be limited to an initial receipt and a certificate of proper expenditure at the determination of the project.

Called Mr. Kent and asked him to brief Gen. McNarney tomorrow morning. He will call [redacted] this afternoon and get all the details for the briefing.

Meeting with [redacted] of Commo about their revised budget for 1952. There is such a large increase that this will have to be brought up before the PRC and then to the Budget for release of contingency funds.

Called Gen. McClelland and advised him that the Director [redacted] would like to be more fully briefed on the Commo project [redacted].

Talked to Mr. Dulles about his meeting with Mr. Lawton of Bureau of the Budget. It has been suggested that we should contact Senator Russell about our building item in the appropriations bill.
