DAILY STAFF MEETING

Wednesday, 9 January 1952

PRESENT: Messrs. Becker, Reber, Earman, Davidson, Harvey, Dines, Col. Hansen,
and [redacted]

1. Mr. Becker approved [redacted] request to permit the
National Estimates Board to examine the DCI's [redacted]
[redacted]

2. Col. Hansen reported that Shane McCarthy had been instructed
to inform the members of the Orientation Course this morning that remarks
at the Course yesterday by the DCI, re the budget for the proposed Agency
building, were made in strictest confidence for their own information only.

3. In a discussion re the proposed new building (information
furnished by Mr. Harvey and Col. Hansen) it was stated that:

- a. The Agency had requested [redacted] dollars
but Congress probably would not appropriate
over [redacted]
- b. Of three sites considered by the Agency,
[redacted] was preferred but would require the
[redacted] dollars for development.
- c. A ^{new} building at [redacted] would probably
require the larger sum to meet [redacted]
approval.
- d. Langley would be the only choice for a [redacted]
dollar "warehouse" type building.

4. Mr. Dines informed Mr. Becker that FBI would call (probably
today) requesting DCI to ask State to issue a visa for an FBI agent to
attend the Union Conference in Moscow. Mr. Becker instructed Mr. Dines to
contact AD/SO who should submit the matter to DCI.
