1. Mr. Davidson reported on special briefings this morning for DD/I on Iranian situation (Mossadeq's latest blast) and a special paper on Burma (OCI) for DCI briefing.

2. A brief discussion was held on the present disagreements held by US intelligence services [redacted] as reported by McCloy (State cable 1809) and Truscott's cable to DCI on same subject. Mr. Reber reported that Jim Hunt was to advise Truscott that the matter was to be aired at IAC (24 Jan.) and would then be given Agency instructions. In the meantime, Mr. Reber said more meetings would be held between IAC representatives before the IAC meeting of 24 January.

3. Col. Hansen reported that an Agency employee may be involved in the Butler-Tydings investigations. It was decided an item would be entered in the DCI's log on this subject.
