Director's Meeting

PRESENT: Mr. Dulles, Mr. Becker, Col. White, Col. Taylor, Messrs. Hedden and Earman.

Mr. Dulles:

S. 2-12-52

a. Noted that in recent correspondence prepared in OPC they had referred to the "war room" and asked if this was in fact a proper reference and should we not use some other designation. Col. Taylor undertook to look into this matter. Mr. Kulich reports this has been done - 14 Feb. 52.

c. Noted the item in today's Log concerning the [redacted] and asked Col. Taylor to bring this project before the PRC at its next meeting for a "review". He also stated that in the future projects which were not "doing so good" would be reviewed by PRC.

d. Reported on a recent conversation he had with [redacted] and noted that he intended to ask the Director to discuss [redacted] and his position with us with the President.

e. Reported on the discussion he and [redacted] had yesterday with representatives of the Department of State concerning [redacted] and stated that [redacted] was preparing a detailed memo of conversation.

f. Asked Mr. Becker to furnish him the subject matter of the OCI briefings held on Tuesdays and Fridays in order that he might make arrangements to attend these briefings from time to time. Mr. Hedden asked that he be furnished this information also.

g. Stated that Col. Baird had informed him that Shane MacCarthy had been requested by Georgetown University to give a series of lectures on the philosophy of Communism. After some discussion, Mr. Earman undertook to get further information from Baird on this matter.

Mr. Becker:

[redacted] and that he was experiencing difficulties within the Agency as a result of security measures desired by the covert offices. [redacted] noted that he thought this had been ironed out. After some discussion, Mr. Becker undertook to discuss this matter further with [redacted] also noted that a progress report on this project was being prepared for the Secretary of Defense and would be ready the latter part of this week.


Mr. Becker:

b. Stated that he had discussed with Col. Baird the need for a one-day CIA indoctrination course for the individual members of the IAC and for about ten of their high-level people and that Baird would submit an outline of such a course to him for consideration.

Mr. Hedden:

a. Raised the question of medical treatment for our people abroad and referred particularly to those individuals who might require a general anesthetic. He noted in this connection that some provision should be made in order to protect our people from a security standpoint. Col. White stated that CIA regulations did provide for approved medical facilities abroad. Mr. Dulles noted that this matter might bear further looking into and Col. White undertook to do so. *S. 2-11-52* ✓
