Director's Meeting


Tuesday, 3 June 1952

PRESENT: General Smith, Messrs. Dulles, Wisner, Wolf, Becker, Earman

General Smith:

a. Referred to the cable received from Aurell on 2 June concerning his (Aurell's) discussion with Ambassador Murphy and funds for the [ ] Project and stated that we should not delay too long in sending the first increment of these funds. Mr. Wisner said he believed [ ] had been allotted this project about ten days ago and undertook to look into this matter and advise Aurell accordingly.

Mr. Dulles:



Mr. Wisner:

a. Noted that he had talked with [ ] yesterday as requested by the Director and that he had undertaken to have him see [ ] concerning possible employment with Radio Free Europe.

b. Raised the question of approach concerning the [ ] problem and stated he intended to first discuss this matter with the navy and, in particular, with Admiral Radford upon his arrival. The Director approved and stated that if an impasse was reached on securing the use [ ] for our purposes he would then take this matter up with the Secretary of the Interior.
