
Deputies' Meeting

Friday, 5 September 1952

PRESENT: General Smith, Messrs. Dulles, Wolf, Becker, Helms, Hedden, Earman

General Smith:

□ ----- a. Stated that a "sanitized" copy of the CIA Situation Summary would be used in the future in briefing the Presidential candidates. HR70-14



b. Referred to a cable from [Redacted] concerning FBI activities in [Redacted] and, after some discussion, the Director stated [Redacted] should be advised there had been no change in our agreement with the FBI regarding their liaison activities abroad. [Redacted] undertook to dispatch an appropriate cable.

c. Noted that we were going ahead with our arrangements to make use of [Redacted] offer of assistance in the [Redacted] Organization. The Director undertook to advise Assistant Secretary of Defense Anna Rosenberg as to [Redacted] activities for CIA.

Mr. Dulles (Cont'd.)

d. Noted that Chet Hansen had requested an assignment overseas with CIA and failing this wished to return to the Air Force. The DCI approved and directed Mr. Earman to employ Col. Stanley J. Grogan, USA (ret.) as Hansen's replacement.

Mr. Becker:

a. Noted that in a conversation with Mr. Francis Shackelford, Counselor for the Department of the Army, Shackelford had indicated that on the basis of a meeting he and Mr. Pace had with Papagos it appeared that his health was failing and he would not "last out the year."

Mr. Hedden:

a. Reported that Corcoran had agreed to stay over in connection with CAT as discussed with the Director yesterday.

c. Briefly discussed the advancement of employees without college degrees. The Director stated that the lack of a degree should not in any way hinder the advancement of any qualified employee and asked Mr. Wolf to have Gen. Morris look into this matter.

Mr. Helms:

a. Noted a cable [Redacted] indicating the possibility of a revolt there and, in response to a query from the Director as to the evaluation of this report, stated there had not been sufficient time to make an analysis.
