Deputies' Meeting

Tuesday, 23 December 1952

PRESENT: General Smith, Messrs. Wisner, Wolf, Amory, Helms, Earman

General Smith:

a. Asked Mr. Wolf to obtain from Senator Bingham a copy of his testimony in the [redacted] case.

b. Stated that Mr. William H. Jackson had agreed to accept the chairmanship of the "to-be-appointed psychological strategy group".

c. Asked Mr. Amory to set up a procedure whereby Mr. John Foster Dulles would receive on a daily basis copies of the intelligence reports which are placed on his (DCI's) desk each morning. Mr. Amory stated that action on this was already under way and Mr. Dulles would receive the first reports tomorrow morning.

Mr. Wisner:

Mr. Amory:

a. Stated that (1) a "report" had been received which indicated that a [redacted] had arrived in that country with highly classified information on U.S. atomic energy activities; (2) this report had been given to the FBI and so far it had been determined that this individual had departed New York on 30 September.
