In September 1954, Marshal Zhukov was in charge of Soviet Army maneuvers at Totskaya (N 52-31, E 52-44) in the Caspian Sea area. Several corps of special units [types not specified] participated in these maneuvers, which included the tactical use of atomic weapons [types not specified]. For his part in the maneuvers, Zhukov was awarded a special commendation by Marshal Bulganin on behalf of the Soviet Government.
