Appraisal of Content: 6.

1. During the Korean War, the Trans-Baykal Military District was practically on a war footing. Large quantities of Soviet technical equipment [number and kind not specified] were sent to Korea, and large groups [number not specified] of Chinese came to the Trans-Baykal Military District for training. Informant provided no further information on the subject.
2. The V. Ch. [Voyskovaya chast - military unit number] of a unit [not further identified] at the Kadaga Airfield¹, near Chita [N 52-03, E 113-30] (the headquarters for the Trans-Baykal Military District) is 58100.

1. [REDACTED] Comment: This is probably the Chita/Kadala Airfield, located at N 52-01, E 113-19.
