

PREFACE

This report is one in a series on Soviet Ground Force and logistic installations being prepared for a DIA/CIA Panel. The series is being coordinated, published and disseminated by NPIC. The photographic analysis is being performed by the NPIC Photographic Analysis Group, the CIA Photographic Intelligence Division (NPIC), and the Production Center 1P1c (DIA). The photographic analysis for this particular report was performed by the NPIC Photographic Analysis Group.

In the interest of uniformity, the titles and letter designators for the facilities observed at these installations are identical with those appearing in the project requirement. When a specific facility is not observed both its title and letter designator are omitted in the report.

Titles and letter designators for the various facilities are as follows: (A) railroad service, (B) road service, (C) landing strips, (D) administrative and troop housing areas, (E) storage areas, (F) ammunition storage areas, (G) POL storage areas, (H) other buildings and facilities, (J) equipment storage/maintenance areas, (K) athletic fields, (L) small arms firing ranges, (M) driver training areas, (N) tank/assault gun firing ranges, (P) flat trajectory firing ranges, (Q) artillery emplacements (batteries), (R) infantry or combined arms field training area or courses, (S) special training facilities, (T) unidentified facilities or tracking activity.




FIGURE 1. LOCATION OF CHUGUYEV ARMY BARRACKS WEST.

SUMMARY

Chuguyev Army Barracks West is located in the central part of Chuguyev (Figure 1). A training area (TA-1) located southeast of Chuguyev is probably associated with this installation.





FIGURE 3. CHUGUYEV ARMY BARRACKS WEST. Sketch compiled from [redacted] August 1964.

The installation covers approximately 40 acres and contains one multistory administrative building, 5 multistory barracks, 18 general storage buildings, foundations for 2 probable storage buildings, 2 vehicle sheds, and 3

support buildings (Figures 2 and 3).

The area is covered by 1960 TALENT photography and 5 KEYHOLE missions between April 1962 and August 1964. Between February 1960 and April 1962 a storage building, a small-arms range, and an athletic field were removed, a new storage building was erected, and the foundations for 2 other storage buildings were laid. The installation appears active on all photography.

DESCRIPTION OF INSTALLATION

Railroad Service

The closest rail facility is 1.5 kilometers (km) south of the installation.

Road Service

The installation has direct access to Chuguyev streets and the Chuguyev-Kharkov all-weather highway.

Administrative and Troop Housing Area

Area D contains one T-shaped multistory administrative building and 5 multistory barracks. The area appears active.

General Storage Area

Area E contains 18 general storage buildings, 2 possible general storage buildings under construction, and 3 support buildings. Between February 1960 and April 1962 one storage building was removed, one was built, and the foundations for 2 others were laid.

Equipment Storage/Maintenance Area

Area J contains two 240- by 50-foot vehicle sheds. Equipment was observed in this area on 1960 photography.
