OCCUPANCY AND ACTIVITY

The only buildings observed with some snow on the roofs are 8 vehicles sheds and 11 storage buildings. All barracks, quarters and administration buildings appear occupied. Vehicular and personnel scarring is observed throughout the installation.

PI REMARKS

Part of this barracks area is probably used for housing personnel from Stry Airfield as there are no other housing facilities of a military nature available in the area.

All measurements have been made by the CIA/IAD project analyst. They should not be construed as being mensuration data compiled by the NPIC Technical Intelligence Division.


