OSLO--AN URGENT APPEAL FOR HELP AND SUPPORT FROM WORKERS IN THE CZECH AIRLINE COMPANY CSA TONIGHT WAS MONITORED BY A DUTCH PLANE, ACCORDING TO AIRLINE OFFICIALS.

THE SOURCES SAID A DUTCH KLM PASSENGER PLANE FLYING OVER WEST GERMANY RECEIVED THIS AERIAL MESSAGE FROM NEIGHBORING CZECHOSLOVAKIA:

"TO ALL TRADE UNION ORGANIZATIONS OF AIR COMPANIES,

"TO ALL WORKERS OF THE WORLD AIRLINES:

"DEAR FRIENDS: EMPLOYEES OF CSA URGENTLY REQUEST THAT YOU IMMEDIATELY HELP OUR COUNTRY. IT IS OCCUPIED AGAINST THE WILL OF OUR PEOPLE AND OUR LEGAL GOVERNMENT BY ENEMY ARMIES OF THE SOVIET UNION, BULGARIA, HUNGARY, POLAND AND THE GDR (EAST GERMANY).

"OUR CITIZENS ARE BEING KILLED, OUR CULTURAL MONUMENTS ARE BEING DESTROYED AND THERE ARE EVEN SIGNS OF LOOTING. PLEASE HELP US TO KEEP OUR FREEDOM. PLEASE INFORM YOUR GOVERNMENTS AND ALL YOUR WORKING PEOPLE AND ASK THEM TO ORGANIZE ACTIONS FOR SUPPORT FOR THE OCCUPIED CSSR.
