

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: Conversation with Mr. William Hahn, Continental Air Services, Inc. (CASI)

1. On 9 January 1970, Mr. [] hosted a luncheon meeting with Mr. William Hahn and Mr. Alan Warfield. Mr. Hahn was en route to the Far East via Europe and stopped in Washington to see Agency representatives.

2. Mr. Hahn again expressed his concern over the activities of the Far East Pilots Association and the decision to recognize it. It was suggested to him that he stop in Taipei to learn first hand the progress of negotiations between FEPA and Air America and to assess the character of FEPA. Mr. Warfield said that he would alert Mr. Grundy to the possibility of a visit by Mr. Hahn.

3. Mr. Warfield asked Mr. Hahn if CASI had been asked to bid on the Air Vietnam requirement for cockpit air crews and aircraft for its domestic service. Mr. Hahn said that he wasn't sure but had been asked to provide management of a pool of pilots. He didn't know whether this was related or not.

4. Mr. Hahn said that CASI was reevaluating its position in Vietnam. CASI does not like the new Vietnamese officials with whom they must deal and is unsure what equities lie in continuing on in Vietnam. His present trip is related to this examination.
