

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE TO COVER USAID WORK
PERFORMED BY AACL UNDER SUB-CONTRACT FROM
AIR AMERICA, INC.

1. AACL will issue an invoice to AAM for all such work.
2. The invoice should be sent to Air America in care of MAAL HKG.
3. AAM HKG will then put a covering AAM invoice on this AACL invoice and forward both of these to MFA SGN for his distribution to USAID and for eventual collection by AAM.
4. Payment will be made by AAM HKG upon receipt of payment from USAID but in any event not later than 60 days after issuance of the invoice.


Dear Mr. Bevans:

Confirming our telex to you of this date, E-Systems agrees to extend the subject contract for one month to July 31, 1975, on all existing terms and conditions except for necessary rate changes as follows:

1. The labor rate set forth in Article III(A) shall be \$5.05 per direct skilled labor hour. The new rate for July is the same as the rate effective July 1 on competitive U. S. Navy contracts.
2. The rate for special services set forth in Article III(D) shall be \$18,000 for the extension period of July 1975. The nature of these services has substantially changed, and we have recalculated services which could be priced at the present time to support this fixed rate.
3. Materials purchased under Article III(E) shall be charged at AACL's standard commercial rates as published in Sales and Services Manual 2-6, entitled "Standard Material Rates," dated 1 February 1975. This list describes varying percentages of uplift over in-bin cost depending on unit dollar value and are used for all customers except the U. S. Government.

If extension through July 31, 1975, on the above terms and conditions is acceptable, please telex agreement to the attention of the undersigned. On receipt of telex, the extension shall be deemed to be contractually in effect. Please confirm your acceptance by signing the enclosed copy of this letter in the space indicated and returning to the undersigned.
