SUBJECT: Mikola Abramtchik

Reference: Phone conversations 1 May and 4 May between [ ] [ ]  
and [ ] [ ] same subject

1. The meeting about which you were advised during referenced conversations took place as scheduled, and the following resulted:

a. According to Abramtchik, a meeting took place between a [ ] [ ] and General Kushal about four or five months ago. This meeting lasted about six hours, however, all questions were not answered, and, according to Abramtchik, several items were tabled, to be taken up again with Abramtchik preferably in Kushal's presence.

b. Abramtchik would like to see [ ] [ ] to discuss certain matters concerning Major Nagula. Abramtchik states that he has suggestions to make relative to the Major.

c. Abramtchik is in the US currently as a representative of a Coordination Committee of Non-Russian Organizations representing six nationalities (Ukrainians, Georgians, Azerbaijanis, North Caucasians, Armenians, and Byelorussians). This Coordination Committee was founded in Europe for the purpose of representing Non-Russian groups willing to associate themselves with the American Committee for the Liberation of the Peoples of Russia. Abramtchik, as spokesman of the Coordination Committee, plans to continue promising conversations held in Paris with Admiral Stevens, head of the American Committee, which he hopes will provide basis for inclusion of the nationality groups in the American Committee on basis of equality with the Russians. To bring this about, Abramtchik intends to talk to various people in the American Committee, including [ ] [ ] Abramtchik plans to stay in New York for about two months.

2. In the event you have difficulty in identifying either [ ] or [ ] this office can provide their true identities. Additionally, this office would be pleased to make arrangements for
