SUBJECT: Project Review Committee Action 4 April 1952

1. The Project Review Committee took action on the following projects at a meeting convened 4 April:

a. AE-ACRE, Amendment No. 1.

Acting on this project, the PRC:

(1) Endorsed the current program for FY 1952 (previously approved by ADSO) for which funds had been made available to acquire by rental 5 safehouse training sites in the Washington area;

(2) Approved in principle that up to five additional sites might be purchased to complete the FY 1952 program in the event that rental sites are not obtainable (specific authorization will be acquired for such purchase.)

(3) Granted permission for the development of a one-package program to provide this sort of facility. In this connection, the solution might be to acquire a large area, preferably Government owned, on which individual training sites could be spotted.

The PRC did not approve the [] for FY 1952³ and required it to be re-submitted at a later date.

Communications Annex

I Introduction

The purpose of this Annex is to establish communications support to the Domestic Operating Base known as AE-ACRE for fiscal year 1953 until the expiration or cancellation of the basic project.

A. Conditions of Support

1. Interpreters may be needed for the training of certain of these units. These interpreters will be supplied by SR Division and trained by the Office of Communications. These interpreters will remain under the control of the SR Division.

2. The SR Division will make available to the Office of Communications information necessary for the proper training of individuals. Such information will be presented on a standard Request for Training form and will include the clearance possessed by the trainee, the specific area of operation and the language to be used in the operation.

3. As outlined in the basic project, SR Division will provide the sites for training and transportation where necessary.

4. It is necessary that the Office of Communications personnel ceiling be increased by 6 positions.

II Statement of SupportA. Equipment

1. Equipment necessary to communications training will be made available. No additional funds will be required for this purpose.

B. Personnel

1. Support of this project is predicated upon the establishment of a Communications Table of Organization of 6 positions for this specific purpose.

2. These positions, without which this project cannot be supported, will be in addition to the personnel ceiling presently imposed upon the Office of Communications. Such positions will be used solely in support of AE-ACRE.

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3. These additional positions are necessary to provide adequate support to AE-ACFE without eliminating the support given by the Covert Training Section to other covert training requirements.

4. The following positions are requested in support of this project, based upon an anticipated requirement of ten units receiving simultaneous training:
