1. Munich, Germany, MAT, Lithuanian SSR.
2. MGMA-1988; MGKW-2574; MGMA-2969.
3. a. Development of support bases in the Lithuanian SSR using Lithuanian underground personnel and support facilities for the purpose of 1) procuring intelligence from the Baltic States and 2) serving as transit points for operations against the USSR proper.
- b. Development of communications between the Lithuanian SSR and Am/Zone Germany through establishment of w/t links and development of sea, land and air courier routes for two-way movement of personnel, supplies, and information.
- c. Procurement of intelligence on important Baltic target areas designated in MGKW-7757.

5. In American Zone/Germany all top ranking CAPSTAN representatives as well as courier personnel in training are contacted directly by the case officer. Contact with CAPSTAN personnel residing outside of Germany but in western Europe is maintained through the facilities offered by []
6. Contact with the Lithuanian SSR is expected to be maintained, as it has been in the past, through w/t communications and s/w letters mailed to drops outside the Iron Curtain area.
7. Control over all personnel is based on ideological grounds, i.e., mutual co-operation for the realization of Lithuanian national aspirations.

8. Equipment of courier teams with documentation, clothing, radio communications apparatus, s/w materials, weapons, ammunition, funds and valuables as well as provision of facilities for air and/or sea dispatch.
9. Coordination is desirable with [] Berlin, []
[] for the effective conduct of this project.
10. This Project was initiated approximately two years ago. The first dispatch, consisting of [] took place at the end of September, 1950. To date 2 s/w letters from [] have been received by [] in Paris. 16 messages have been transmitted from MDE to [] and 12 have been received, the last on 8 December 1950. The second team, consisting of [] with [] as jump master is ready for dispatch. The first alert was held from 16 to 30 January and the second from 14 to 25 March. Operations were frustrated by unfavorable weather conditions. The third alert will begin on 13 April and extend to 23 April. Date of termination of this project is not contemplated at this time.

However, it is desirable to have at least a limited amount of these items in reserve for "special purposes", such as entertainment and complimentary presents to CAPSTAN representatives with whom we meet for conferences.
