MEMORANDUM FOR: Chief of Foreign Intelligence

SUBJECT: Project AECHEMP (Amendment)

1. AMENDMENT PROVISION: An amendment to this currently approved project is requested to provide an additional sum to cover the costs incurred in the development of the [] , a REDSKIN operation into the USSR. At the time AECHEMP was submitted for renewal it was anticipated that operation [] would shortly be submitted for approval as a separate project. However, the operation did not develop quickly enough and the charges to Project AECHEMP, incurred by the development of [] , were greater during this fiscal year than had been anticipated.

2. COST: Project AECHEMP was approved by Deputy Chief, FI on 8 October 1953 for the period 1 July 1953 through 30 June 1954 at a cost of [] . The total cost of this amendment, incurred in the development of [] , is [] . This amendment, if approved would raise to [] the total authorized for the approval period of this project. (Note: Approval of these funds is requested from the present ODP-SR Division budget for this fiscal year and on the assumption that sufficient funds will be available from the budget for the next fiscal year to carry this project through the remainder of the approval period requested.) The SR Division is transferring [] allocated in the budget to AECOB to AECHEMP to cover the amount required by this amendment.
