**E. Miscellaneous Comments:** The present visit of the Latvian Minister in London, **Zerins**, to the United States and Canada is being closely followed for its possible contribution to the unification of the Latvian emigration. The headquarters case officer will shortly visit Germany on TDY where he will discuss the whole range of problems and plans pertinent to Latvian political and psychological warfare activities.

**F. Information required by ADPC memorandum entitled "Inventory of OPC Operational Assets and Capabilities".**

1. The asset is the Latvian emigre newspaper **Latvya**, published in Germany.
2. Limited control is exercised by us as a result of our partial subsidization of the paper.
3. The paper's reading public is confined primarily to several thousand Latvian emigres in Germany. It serves the purpose of preserving a spirit of unity among the emigres.
