11. Summary

- a. On 21 April 1953 [] stated that a monitoring of Radio Riga had revealed a sweeping cabinet shake-up in which Russians have replaced six Latvian Ministers in the Latvian SSR.
- b. This tightening of security appears to be dictated by fear of reaction in the non-Russian Republics to unpopular measures directed at speeding up agricultural and industrial production.
