1. We presume that Reference A refers to a purely formal annual project renewal and is not a reflection of the current substantive discussion related to the Agent's usefulness and security.

2. In References B and C, *[Handwritten mark]* stated that it wished to work with AEDOGMA/1 through April 1960 in order to evaluate his future usefulness on the basis of concrete production. Since AEDOGMA/1 was in Munich, away from his basic area of operations, for approximately two months this past winter, it is requested that a corresponding extension of two months be granted. Before the end of June we hope to have a definite idea of AEDOGMA/1's usefulness in Paris and will submit a progress report with appropriate recommendations.

3. For your information, AEDOGMA/1 returned from Munich with serious damage to his morale as a result of the questions raised re his security and general usefulness. The Writer let him talk himself out and then told him that the organization in general would, as in the past, decide on the basis of results, which depend entirely on the agent's own objective efforts. The Writer added that he, personally, was strongly optimistic and would make every effort to help him succeed. AEDOGMA/1 is now working with his customary enthusiasm, has recruited an unwitting spotter at the School of Oriental Languages, is in social contact with a young Frenchwoman of Ukrainian descent who will spend a year in Moscow as a French Government scholarship recipient, is active in penetrating Ukrainian youth groups and in running down a number of other leads as well.
