1. Project (Cryptonym): AEBASIN
2. Precis of operation, mechanism, target:

A psychological warfare type operation, AEBASIN supports the activities of Estonian emigres and emigre groups directed against the Estonian SSR. These activities include radio broadcasts, mailing operations, liaison with emigre organizations, PP briefings for legal travelers, and exploitation of other media which have PP potentialities.

3. This project refers to priority A, objective 2, tasks b / d of the ^{German Soviet RMD} applicable RMD which requires (quote pertinent passage):

Facilitate evolutionary changes within the USSR...To this end increase popular demands for greater freedom...aggravate frictions between Soviet and Satellite parties and governments.

Disseminate facts to the Soviet people inside the USSR through effective covert media. Utilize selected emigre organizations for propaganda and political action.

The RMD for Spain, priority B, objective 2, is also applicable: Continue to exploit the foreign broadcasts facilities of Radio Nacional and to improve, without impairing their Spanish flavor, the effectiveness of their broadcasts to the Sino-Soviet bloc.

4. If the priority noted in reply to #3 above is not "A", are the other, higher priority objectives adequately taken care of--or impossible to achieve at present--so that this project aimed at a lower priority target is sufficiently justified?

This project covers the task as it relates to one Baltic country, Estonia. In regard to the Spanish RMD, AEBASIN again covers the task insofar as that is possible through supporting broadcasts to one Soviet Republic.

8. Additional Comments:

It has been almost impossible to evaluate the effectiveness of the radio operations of this project. Consequently, the Division has initiated a program to attempt to determine the effectiveness of its radio operations. It is expected that prior to FY 1960 renewal time the Division will have sufficient data so that the value of these operations will be known. The Division will also improve and increase the project's mailing operations and legal traveler operations.
