\* MARCILIONIS, Balys, born 1905 at KILDISKIS, Lithuania:

SUBJECT, born 1 May 1900 at KILDISKIS, was investigated as a visa applicant in 1951. The investigation revealed no derogatory information. (B-2) SUBJECT attended elementary, high, and commercial school from 1909 to 1925. From 1925 to 1927, he attended the University of LEIPZIG, and from 1928 to 1932, he attended the University of GRAZ. From 1932 to 1944, he was a bank executive and a professor at the University of Commerce in SIAULIAI, Lithuania. In 1944, SUBJECT fled from the Russians and resided in GRAZ, where he worked as a laborer. From 1945 to 1949, he lived privately and at Camp Memmingen. In 1950 he worked as a legal advisor for the IRO in AUGSBURG. (F-6) At the time of the investigation, SUBJECT was residing at DF Camp Hochfeld. (B-2) No further information available.
