SUBJECT: GENERAL REDSOX/AERODYNAMIC  
SPECIFIC Courier Reception Plan

The following plan has been developed for the reception of the CANNPORE couriers in event their exfiltration is successful.

1. As soon as word is received that the couriers have arrived,  and CASSOWARY 6 will proceed to the reception point and escort them to a safehouse in the Munich area. This safehouse should be prepared well in advance of the anticipated time of arrival, and preferably one not previously used for KUDARK activities.

2. The couriers stay in Germany will be limited to the time necessary for coordination with interested agencies so as to facilitate their travel to and entrance into the United States. During their stay at the safehouse CASSOWARY 3 should be allowed to receive their report as well as review the contents of the pouch. Also CASSOWARY 6 should probably remain with the new arrivals until they leave as further evidence of CASSOWARY 1 participation in this operation. This plan will avoid an accusation by CASSOWARIES of lack of faith on our part and a repetition of the incident in 1950, when the couriers who exfiltrated were held by American personnel for three days before a CASSOWARY 1 member was allowed to see them. CASSOWARY 2 understands and stated that all of the material contained in the pouch will be placed at the disposal of KUDARK when delivered to him by the couriers.

3. Headquarters has initiated action for special procedures to go into effect, which will enable the couriers enter the United States black. As soon as the couriers are in the safehouse, the following additional background information must be cabled to Headquarters:

- a. Full name
- b. Date and place of birth
- c. Family background (names and place birth, mother, father, brothers etc.)

d. Educational background


This information, upon receipt at headquarters, will initiate action required to obtain clearance of the couriers for entrance into the U.S. Soon as clearance is obtained a headquarters case officer accompanied by CASSOWARY 4 will depart for Munich. These two plus security personnel will accompany the couriers on the flight to the United States.

4. Headquarters has alerted the Air Section here on the need of a special ~~NS~~ ~~SECRET~~ type air flight to the U.S. for this movement. The headquarters Air Section has agreed that such a flight can be arranged limiting the flight to the two couriers and ~~NUMAN~~ cleared personnel. The ~~AMERICAN~~ field case officer should coordinate with the Air Section at Frankfurt of this possibility and dependent successful exfiltration.

A safehouse will be made available here for the holding and possible training of these couriers. The entire debriefing of the couriers will be accomplished in the U.S. The pouch material will be retained by the couriers and delivered to CASSOWARY 2 upon their arrival at the safehouse.

5. The number of ~~NUMAN~~ personnel contacting the couriers should be kept to the bare minimum necessary for establishing their bona fides and arranging for their transportation to the U.S. CASSOWARY 2 stressed the hope that CASSOWARY 3 will use the couriers because of his official position in CASSOWARY 1, headquarters agrees this should be possible.

6. Attached is a letter written by CASSOWARY 2 for CASSOWARY 3, outlining the plan as submitted to you in this dispatch. The only change is the statement in the letter that CASSOWARY 6 would accompany the couriers to the United States. CASSOWARY 2 agreed (after he had written the letter) that since CASSOWARY 6's documents are not in order that he should not be used. Therefore, CASSOWARY 4 will depart here with headquarters case officer for this mission.
