SUBJECT: Operational Meeting with AECASSOWARY 15

1. At the request of AECASSOWARY 15, the Case Officer visited him on 30 March. At the ensuing meeting, AECASSOWARY 15 told Case Officer that he had had a telephone conversation with AECASSOWARY 2 in which AECASSOWARY 2 told him of receiving a letter from AECAVATINA 5 requesting that he visit London sometime prior to 15 April. AECAVATINA 5 stressed the importance of AECASSOWARY 2 making this visit in order that he might pass on to him w/T traffic as received over the past several years from MIRON and to talk to JAVELIN representatives regarding the recently arrived courier to JAVELIN from MIRON, the ZCh set-up and future contact with the Homeland headquarters.
2. AECASSOWARY 2 instructed AECASSOWARY 15 to inform us of the request for his presence in London and to find out what we thought of it. The Case Office told AECASSOWARY 15 that as much as it was desirable to obtain from AECAVATINA 5 the w/T traffic sent by MIRON, or for AECASSOWARY 2 to question the courier, etc., it was contrary to our way of doing business for AECASSOWARY 2 to hold talks with JAVELIN on operational matters without first having the usual JAVELIN-KUBARK understanding in the matter, or at least a request or notification from JAVELIN that they are interested in speaking with AECASSOWARY 2.
3. AECASSOWARY 15 agreed that JAVELIN should have said something to us about what they had in mind, but, he continued, since there were pressing matters to be resolved immediately as far as JAVELIN and the ZCh net was concerned, AECASSOWARY 2 should be on his way as soon as possible.
4. Armed with our reaction to AECASSOWARY 2 's request to visit JAVELIN, AECASSOWARY 15 visited AECASSOWARY 2 on the following day.
5. AECASSOWARY 15 returned from his visit with AECASSOWARY 2 with a toned down version of JAVELIN'S interest in wanting to see AECASSOWARY 2, this time emphasizing AECAVATINA 5's desire to see AECASSOWARY 2 instead. He admitted, of course, that JAVELIN would naturally want to see AECASSOWARY 2 while he was in London. To the reasons why AECASSOWARY 2 should visit London, AECAVATINA 5 and JAVELIN, AECASSOWARY 15 added the following as discerned from the AECAVATINA 5 letter to AECASSOWARY 2: a) the 15 April deadline for AECASSOWARY 2 visit to London was based on the fact that JAVELIN planned to dispatch the courier sometime after that date (this is contrary to AECAVATINA 5's original statement of wanting to turn this courier over to the ZP), b) since AECAVATINA 5 had honored AECASSOWARY 2's position of being in charge of homeland contact for both ZCh and ZP according to the homeland directive, he was anxious to discuss future one-lin communications with AECASSOWARY 2.
6. AECASSOWARY 2 's desire to go to London, aside from the reasons listed above, is also based on the fact that he is under obligation to discuss future homeland contact with other members of the ZCh since they are depending on him to take the initiative in this respect. As he sees it, JAVELIN support of the "Duo" and the new ZCh is contingent on operational cooperation. And because of this, the ZCh is anxious for AECASSOWARY 2 to make the necessary arrangements with JAVELIN and AECAVATINA 5 regarding operations

if political and other support is to be forthcoming from JAVELIN.

7. To fulfill his role as chief of homeland contact, AECASSOWARY 2 deems it imperative that he have the old w/t traffic exchanged between JAVELIN and MIRON and which AECAVATINA 5 is willing to turn over to him. Also, for future operations, AECAVATINA 5 wants to discuss the integration of his agent cadre into the scheme of things involving AECASSOWARY 2. AECASSOWARY 2 has already asked the Case Officer whether we are in a position to accept these agent recruits if and when available.

8. Pending an answer from JAVELIN to our request ~~mi~~ regarding their interest in wanting to see AECASSOWARY 2, the Case Officer suggested that AECASSOWARY 2 visit Washington on or about 9 April to discuss these above mentioned developments.

9. Aside from the operational matters to be discussed with AECASSOWARY 2, he also requested an audience with   for the purpose of discussing such matters as the US attitude regardinn the new ZCh, the American Committee and other political topics of interest to him.
