Protection of AECASSOWARY 1 card files

1. On 6 December 1955, it was impressed upon AECASSOWARY 3 and 6 that they should undertake appropriate action to insure the protection of the AECASSOWARY 1 card files. The AECASSOWARY 1 card files and related material, according to AECASSOWARY 3, are relatively safe since they are kept in the AECASSOWARY 1 publication offices in which establishment Fedir TUREVICH (see ROMA 8060, dated 5 October 1953) has his living quarters. Furthermore, the street entrance to these offices is safeguarded by an iron grill gate, the integrity of which is checked several times each night by the Munich police. The windows to the publication offices are not vulnerable and would not permit penetration from adjoining buildings. Roman TUREVICH, a member of the AECASSOWARY 1 publication staff, is singularly responsible for the card files. AECASSOWARY 3 felt, however, that it would not be amiss to purchase a safe in which this material could be stored; he will suggest that the editorial staff consider this proposition and effect the purchase.

2. On the other hand, according to AECASSOWARY 3, the anti-BANDERA ZCHOUN personality card files present themselves as a very vulnerable target, as do the card files of all the other organizations whose offices are located on Daucherstrasse No 9. AECASSOWARY 3 stated that he will be able to discuss this matter with the appropriate representatives within the anti-BANDERA ZCHOUN and suggest that they take some action to insure the protection of the cards.

3. AECASSOWARY 3 will apprise us what further action will be taken to protect each of the aforementioned card files.
