A) AEDRUMMER 8 agreed to spot AEACRE candidates in SMOOTHER and has already applied for a visa for this purpose. He will notify AECASSOWARY 3 whenever he is prepared to leave. (See attachment B for further information regarding this matter.)

B) There has been some talk of an OUN merger which would include OUN/MELNYK and the ZCHOUN BANDERA and possibly AEDRUMMER 1. It is suspected that Yaroslav HAYVAS is the one instrumental for this move, acting on authority of MELNYK. (See para 3 of Attachment C.)

C) AECASSOWARY 2, displaying poor judgment security-wise, telephoned AECASSOWARY 6 from PBPRIME to alert him to the fact that there are some indications that a number of Ukrainian Soviet Army deserters are now being detained in Austria. AECASSOWARY 6 was advised by AECASSOWARY 2 to make arrangements to investigate this situation. In a return call to AECASSOWARY 2, AECASSOWARY 6 advised AECASSOWARY 2 to present the facts to (See Attachment E.)

D) AECASSOWARY 6 reported that AELIZARD returned to the Homeland and before doing so, wrote to Volodymyr NAZOLA with a request for him to follow suit. On the basis of this letter from AELIZARD, obtained from NAZOLA via AEDRUMMER 10, a plan was devised whereby NAZOLA was to answer AELIZARD for the purpose of enticing the RIS to recruit him. (See Attachment F.) (Note: NAZOLA was approached by the undersigned but refused to participate in the plan set forth in MUNI-0507).

E) Under Project AECARTHAGE, an oral agreement in lieu of contract was drawn up for AECASSOWARY 6 effective 1 November 1956 which calls for...

other things, a salary payment of \$200 a month. For further details regarding this contract and additional comments see EGMA-24067 and 24094.

F) A new safehouse was procured for use by the AERODYNAMIC, AEDRUMMER and AECARTHAGE Projects. AECASSOWARY 6 continues to be safehouse keeper and has begun occupying the new place as of 29 November. ⚡

G) Recent inquiries about Yaroslav HAYVAS' role with the local UUARC office show that HAYVAS is now holding down the post of deputy chief of UUARC here and might possibly stay on as permanent chief at the expiration of the current chief's term in early summer 1956. (See para c Attachment H.)

1. The undersigned visited the AECASSOWARY-6 safehouse hoping to find AECASSOWARY-3 there in order to explain to him AEACRE's plans for Anatoly KAMINSKY to visit SMOOTHER for the purpose of following up AECAVATINA-5's leads to agent candidates. Not finding AECASSOWARY-3 at the safehouse, the undersigned proceeded to explain the nature of his business to AECASSOWARY-6 with instructions that he pass this on to AECASSOWARY-3. AECASSOWARY-6 said he would do this later in the day when he expected to see AECASSOWARY-3.

2. In his opinion, AECASSOWARY-6 felt KAMINSKY would probably accept the offer to visit SMOOTHER for the purpose intended, but added that KAMINSKY has been making plans to emigrate to America. AECASSOWARY-6 did not know the progress KAMINSKY had made to date regarding obtaining a visa, etc., but he said he would try to find out. However, he felt that there was still time for KAMINSKY to carry out the AEACRE assignment as mentioned in DIR-37404. *(to recruit agents)*

3. The undersigned also told AECASSOWARY-6 that he was considering putting him on salary, and explained how part of each monthly salary would be put into escrow for him which he could later draw out if and when he decides to emigrate. AECASSOWARY-6 expressed his appreciation but added that salary or no salary, he would continue doing all he could to help his own organization and us in any anti-Soviet activity. He further added that before accepting this salary offer (\$200.00 a month) he would first have to clear with AECASSOWARY-3, his immediate superior. When asked what he is now earning, if anything, at AECASSOWARY-1, he said he only receives enough to cover expenses and nothing more. No specific figure was mentioned but the undersigned surmised it to be in the neighborhood of approximately 150 DM a month, which all goes for food for AECASSOWARY-6 is his own safehouse keeper and lives rent free in one of our safehouses.

AECASSOWARY 6 Contact Report No. 3

1. AECASSOWARY 6 reported he had negotiated for a new safehouse apartment and, if approved and financial arrangements are made by the undersigned, would move on 15 November. The undersigned gave tentative approval of his selection and said he would probably wrap up the deal on 16 November, including the purchasing of furniture.

2. In the presence of both AECASSOWARY 3 and 6, the undersigned again brought up the matter of putting AECASSOWARY 6 on salary of about \$200.00 per month. This was done since AECASSOWARY 6 had stated earlier that acceptance of such an arrangement required the approval of his immediate superior, AECASSOWARY 3. Thinking in terms of AECASSOWARY 6's past gratis work, future personal requirements in the event he emigrated to America, the nature of the work he is now doing, etc., AECASSOWARY 3 wholeheartedly approved AECASSOWARY 6 receiving the salary mentioned. The undersigned said he would make the necessary arrangements.

3. The undersigned asked AECASSOWARY 3 whether he had heard anything of the proposed OUN/MELNYK/ZH OUN/BANDERA merger. He said talks between these two groups have been progressing for some time now and conducted on the initiative of Jaroslav HAYVAS. There were no definite results to date. AECASSOWARY 3 further stated this attempt at amalgamation was of a political nature involving only OUN units and would probably include AEDRUMMER if effected. He said he would try to learn more details about this move.

AECASSOWARY 3-6 Contact Report No. 2

1. Earlier in the week the undersigned met with AECASS 6 and had asked him to ask AECASS 3 to ask Identity A of MUNI-5552 whether he would be agreeable to accepting an assignment to case AEACRE candidates in SMOOTHER as a follow up to AECAVATINA 5's recent visit. At this meeting, AECASS 3 reported his results. He said Identity A was willing to go to SMOOTHER to spot candidates and in fact had already applied for a visa. According to AECASS 3, Identity A will make the trip to spot and at the same time arrange to attend a SMOOTHER university. After this he will return to Munich for his family. Identity A said he had received a letter from an AEDRUMMER 1 follower in SMOOTHER who has offered him housing during his stay there.

2. AECASSOWARY 3 mentioned that Identity A, who is very well acquainted with the emigre situation in SMOOTHER, knows more potential recruits in SMOOTHER than AECAVATINA 5 and consequently should be in a position to do a thorough job covering the field. However, he would still like to have the names of those people AECAVATINA 5 contacted during his brief visit to SMOOTHER. AECASS 3 said he had learned that AECASS 2 had already gone to Canada to confer with AECAVATINA 5 regarding AEACRE candidates, and he expected AECASS 3 would send these names here via headquarters.

3. The undersigned warned AECASS 3 and 6 that they would have to vacate the currently used safehouse by the end of the month and that it was up to them to locate another place since local army authorities had gone out of the real estate business. They said they would begin looking around.

OPERATIONAL MATTERS AND COMMENTS:

1. AECASSOWARY 6 called about 0930 requesting the undersigned to visit him as he had something important to discuss as a result of a phone call he had received in the middle of the night from AECASSOWARY 2 in PBPRIME. At the safehouse AECASSOWARY 6 (aided by AECASSOWARY 3) related the following:

a) A member of one of the news services (INS, UP-- AECASSOWARY 6 did not know which one specifically) contacted AECASSOWARY 2 in New York and told him that his agency in Austria had talked to several members of the Soviet Army who had defected during the Hungarian revolt and were now held in custody by Austrian authorities. These Soviet Army members, at least those of Ukrainian origin, had asked to be put in touch with a Ukrainian emigre organization, therefore the newspaper man had asked AECASSOWARY 2 whether he could furnish someone from Germany to visit Austria and, through the news services representative there, talk to these Ukrainian Soviet Army members.

b) AECASSOWARY 2 therefore called AECASSOWARY 6 via phone to pass on this information and to determine whether AECASSOWARY 6 could handle the assignment. AECASSOWARY 2 asked AECASSOWARY 6 to call him back after discussing the matter with the undersigned.

c) The undersigned advised AECASSOWARY 6 as follows: i) Apply for an Austrian visa (which takes about three weeks for an "Auslaender" to obtain) immediately in the event a trip to Austria becomes necessary; ii) call AECASSOWARY 2 and instruct him to present all the facts of the case to [] with a request that [] then cable the details to MOB and Vienna, including a request that Vienna look into the matter.

d) The undersigned told AECASSOWARY 6 that the matter would be given further serious thought after word from Washington is received.

2. AECASSOWARY 6 called the undersigned later in the day and advised him that he had called AECASSOWARY 2 and necessary negotiations vis a vis [] were in progress.

OPERATIONAL MATTERS AND COMMENTS:

1. The meeting was called to implement, at least partially, the plan proposed in MUNI 0507 where ~~is~~ Wolodymyr NAZOLA will be approached by the undersigned for possible initiation of something that might turn out to be a GE operation. The undersigned told AECASSOWARY 6 that final approval to approach NAZOLA with the proposition mentioned earlier had not yet been received, but in order to keep AEDRUMMER 10 from spreading the word about NAZOLA receiving a letter from [], it is necessary to take some steps in this direction now. Therefore, the undersigned asked AECASSOWARY 6 to tell AEDRUMMER 10 the letter he got from NAZOLA had been passed to the Americans, and that the Americans have expressed their interest in the matter and will probably want to speak with NAZOLA personally. Further, AECASSOWARY 6 is to caution AEDRUMMER 10 not to tell anyone of what transpired in the case so far and not to take any further interest in the case. AECASSOWARY 6 is to tell AEDRUMMER 10 he will let him know on Friday, 30 Nov. exactly where, when and how he is to meet the American representative. Of course, AEDRUMMER 10 will then contact NAZOLA and pass on this information and report back to AECASSOWARY 6, letting him know NAZOLA's reaction to what he tells him.

2. In the event approval is given to carry out the proposal in MUNI 0507, and NAZOLA is not reluctant to speak with an American representative in the matter, AECASSOWARY 6 will be notified on 30 Nov. to tell AEDRUMMER 10 to tell NAZOLA he is to meet with the American at about 1500 that afternoon. For the meeting place, the undersigned has selected the current AERODYNAMIC safehouse, which is to be vacated by 1 Dec. 1956. Here, the undersigned will tack his name card on the door which will be the name AEDRUMMER 10 will give NAZOLA. (The undersigned will probably use the name []). Incidentally, no one from either AEDRUMMER or AERODYNAMIC, other than AECASSOWARY 3 and 6 knows the location of this safehouse so that AECASSOWARY 3 or 6's connection with the undersigned shall be protected from AEDRUMMER 10 and NAZOLA.

CONTACT REPORT/OPERATIONAL MATTERS AND COMMENTS:

1. Operational matters handled at this brief meeting were as followed:

a) Paid newspaper subsidy (AERODYNAMIC and AEDRUMMER) for the month of December. AECASSOWARY-3 was present to sign the receipts.

b) Paid AECASSOWARY-6 his first month's pay (November) under the terms of the oral agreement recently drawn up for him.

c) The undersigned asked AECASSOWARY-3 about the status of Yaroslav HAYVAS vis-a-vis UUARC in Munich and learned that originally HAYVAS came here at least under partial auspices of UUARC to inspect this organization's activities in Germany. Later, with the outbreak of the Hungarian revolt, he received notification from the home office in America to serve as deputy chief of the local UUARC office until about January or February, 1957. It is unconfirmed but surmised that since the current chief of UUARC expects to leave his post in about June 1957, HAYVAS will probably take over UUARC here permanently.

d) Since approval to implement the plan in MUNI-0507 was given, the undersigned advised AECASSOWARY-6 to inform AEDRUMMER-10 that he, the undersigned, would like to talk with Volodymyr NAZOLA on 30 November. AECASSOWARY-6 will furnish AEDRUMMER 10 the name and address he is to pass on to NAZOLA (George Hall, 15 Geibelstrasse), and will call the undersigned between 1100 and 1200, 30 November, to let him know whether NAZOLA has agreed to this meeting.

e) Since a safehouse was needed to house [] for one night (he was arriving in Munich from Frankfurt later in the day), and since AECASSOWARY-6 was in the process of moving to a new safehouse, the undersigned asked AECASSOWARY-6 to move several hours before schedule in order to accommodate AEBLEACHER. AECASSOWARY-6 asked no questions and said he would be out of the house by 1630.

2. Since there is no phone at the new safehouse, the undersigned asked AECASSOWARY-6 to call him every other day as a routine measure. In the event the undersigned has urgent reasons for wanting to contact AECASSOWARY-6, he will go directly to the safehouse and if AECASSOWARY-6 is out, will leave a note requesting that AECASSOWARY-6 call him. A phone has been ordered but is not expected to be installed for at least two months.

3. The next meeting is to be arranged by phone.
