In order to bring Hq records up-to-date on AEGASSOWARY 1 and ANDRUMMER publications, it is requested that [] obtain from AEGASSOWARY 6 a list of the present personnel employed on the editorial and management staffs of both publications and a breakdown of their respective duties. AEGASSOWARY 2 has been informed of this request and has been asked to obtain information re costs of publication and circulation figures. Please inform AEGASSOWARY 3 that quarterly financial accountings and other materials for AEGASSOWARY 2 which for security reasons should not be relayed by regular mail can be punched to Hq and relayed to AEGASSOWARY 2 by Hq case officer.

2. BRUSSELS FAIR: We would appreciate if [] would inquire of AEGASSOWARY 3 or 6 about any action which the Ukrainian emigration in general, or the CASSOWARIES in particular, might be planning in conjunction with the forthcoming Brussels Fair.
