AERASSOWARY-27 is still in Brussels in charge of AERASSOWARY activities at the Fair.

SUMMARY OF ACTIVITIES:

1. Radio

Eight tapes were prepared by PROLOG ASSOCIATES during the month of August and transmitted over Radio PIREX for a total of 79 transmitter hours. The broadcasts included comments on the following subjects:

- a. Ukrainian youth under new pressure from Moscow.
- b. Membership in the American Communist Party in the past five years has fallen from 80,000 to 5,000, many of the members having left the party after the bloody revolution in Hungary.

- c. Ukrainian lawyer, Roman Hnatyshyn, named assistant head of Canadian Senate.
- d. Five thousand Ukrainian students in the West celebrated 50th anniversary of Ukrainian Students Association.
- e. Discrimination against Ukrainians in the USSR.
- f. Tito urges Hasser not to accept any military aid from Moscow.
- g. Iraq refuses to purchase arms from Moscow.
- h. National freedom movement is main topic of Khrushchev and Mao Tse Tung declaration released in Peking in early August.
- i. USSR and China state they recognize the right of nations to choose their own political system.
- j. Large numbers of Tibetan nationalists flee to Nepal and India.
- k. Ukrainian Section established in Buffalo Museum.

## 2. Publications

Publication of newspapers, ROKHAHA UKRAINA and UKRAINEKYI HANSHYVNYK have continued. The DICTIONARY OF THE SOVIET UKRAINIAN PHRASE is continuing as a monthly by-product of the research activities of ZHOLTO ASSOCIATES and is being supplied to interested Agency components. The August issue of the INFORMATION BULLETIN was published in early August.

## 3. Mailing Operations

3,365 copies of the August issue of INFORMATION BULLETIN were mailed from eight countries into the USSR. It is planned to mail about 200 copies more of the August issue.

## 4. Brussels Fair

Information on AMBASSONARY activities at the Fair has been transmitted by AMBASSONARY-27 via correspondence to AMBASSONARY-2. AMBASSONARIES at the Fair have established contacts with Soviet tourists in Brussels. Conversations were held with Soviet private tourists who arrived by ship and with members of the Ukrainian State Chorus, and autographs were obtained from some of the Chorus members.

An AMBASSONARY representative registered at a Brussels' motel where members of the Ukrainian State Chorus were staying. He mingled with them socially and was able to pass on to them Western literature and ideas and answered many of their questions regarding emigre life in the West. Another AMBASSONARY representative stayed at the same motel and established social contacts with members of the Ukrainian State Chorus.

Contacts at the Fair were effected with two Ukrainians from Poland who took back with them 100 copies of the INFORMATION BULLETIN for mailing into the USSR.

Copies of the INFORMATION BULLETIN were distributed throughout the Soviet Pavilion and were seen to be picked up by Soviet tourists. Copies of the BULLETIN and other Ukrainian literature printed in the West also were given to certain members of the Ukrainian State Chorus at their request;

and souvenir packets of the literature were made up and placed on the tables in the dining room of the motel where members of the Ukrainian State Chorus were staying.

EVALUATION OF EFFECTIVENESS

Ukrainian "bourgeois nationalists" continue to be attacked in the Soviet press. The 18 April 1958 issue of KOMMUNISTSKAYA PRAVDA carried an article regarding the endeavors of "bourgeois nationalists" to influence the youth in every way possible.

There have been increased efforts by the Soviets to cause dissention among the emigration and to discredit the leadership. A recent example: in connection with the 10th anniversary of the establishment of the URRada, a letter was received by ABCASSOWARY-4 (believed to have been sent by the Committee for Return to the Homeland) to which was attached a photostatic copy of a document, containing the signature of Mykola LEVYTS'KY (URRada president), which exposes his supposed collaboration with the German Gestapo against Ukrainian nationalists.
