<p>1. Over the past year approximately 500 copies of the attached publication have been mailed into the Soviet Ukraine from West Germany. AMBASSADORY representatives in Munich have addressed and mailed these bulletins.</p> <p>2. This publication concentrates on criticizing and evaluating oppressive Soviet policies in the Ukraine. The target audience of this KUGAGE operation involves primarily party and government members, university professors, librarians, directors of cultural institutions and similar individuals whose addresses have appeared in overt Soviet publications.</p> <p>3. Headquarters would like to know if BOB facilities could be used for mailing some 50 copies per month from East Germany. If so, would BOB be able to furnish <input type="checkbox"/> <input type="checkbox"/> in Munich with stamps and envelopes? BOB would receive the envelopes from Munich ready for mailing.</p> <p>4. While Headquarters is quite interested in the distribution of this material by means other than mailing from outside the Soviet bloc, we do not want to create an undue burden for BOB's mailing facilities. Your comments and suggestions will be appreciated.</p>
