REFERENCE(S)	EGBW-11769, 3 February 1959  1. BOB's KUCAGE mailing efforts have in the past been conducted almost exclusively by the KUCAGE groups, either German or Emigre. [ ] is, for example, currently mailing to the Soviet Union from East Berlin, using its own facilities and contacts. CAHECTIC is also capable of performing mailing functions such as those requested, but for political reasons related to the future of CAHECTIC, we do not wish at this time to ask them to handle the Ukrainian material. Any arrangement for [ ] to handle the material would have to be made directly between [ ] and AECASSOWARY; we realize, of course, that such an arrangement is most improbable in view of the political differences between the two.  2. BOB independent support facilities could handle this volume of mail but we are most reluctant to use these facilities, particularly on a continuing basis. Reliable support agents are not to be had by the dozen and, as you can well imagine, we currently have numerous priority tasks for our support facilities. We believe it would be short-sighted and most foolish to risk or otherwise endanger these facilities in a purely KUCAGE effort, such as outlined in reference.
