

CHIZHEVSKA, TATIANA

New York Times of 29 August 1960 lists her as one of the American exchange students, who are about to go to the Soviet Union . It further describes her as Assistant Professor of Russian at the University of Illinois.

Dr. P. Turula from Chicago informs that the lady of the above name is a teacher of Russian language at Urbana, the seat of University of Illinois. She is a Ukrainian (Ukrainian students whom she taught the Russian language know her as a Ukrainian. She is probably the daughter of professor ~~fnu~~ CHIZHEVSKY, at present professor at the Slavonic Department, University Heidelberg, Germany.

Constantine Warvariw from Washington, D.C. informs that professor CHIZHEVSKY has a daughter who is a scholar. She was, like her father attached to Harvard University. Professor Chizhevsky is a prominent Ukrainian scholar and author of Ukrainian Literature book, published in recent years. He hailed from Ukraine (Easter). After ~~the~~ WW I he was in Prague, Czechoslovakia and later in Austria and Germany where he taught at Slavic Departments of Universities. After WW II he immigrated to the United States and was connected to Harvard University. In approx. 1958 he received a position at Heidelberg University, Germany.
