1. We concur with reference B in your analysis of the questions raised in reference A.

2. ANGASSONARY/34 is no longer being considered by as a HEDSKIN candidate. We feel sure A/34 would not go since the original purpose was to see his mother and she has emigrated to Sweden.

3. Reference C. We believe it would be mutually advantageous to and FCB if could be present in for a few days EBY when A/29 returns for the reference C debriefing. It would give an opportunity to discuss the future prospects of the AERODYNAMIC project with us and perhaps lead to a quickening of the operational pace which A/29 may be able to generate in with the ANGASSONARY.
