SUBJECT(101 Givins St., Toronto, Ont., Canada) 35-40 years of age immi-  
grated to Canada in 1960 from Poland. Till 1958 she lived in TOVMACH, Western Ukra-  
ine( Stanislav Oblast) and at that time emigrated to Poland. She arrived in Toronto  
with her 16 years old daughter to join her husband , a resident of Toronto. SUBJECT  
is a teacher by profession. She gave the following information:

1. In the uninhabited terrain of the Carpathian Mountains called GORGANY,  
South of Perehinsko, Stanislav Oblast, and particularly along the river BYSTRYTSIA  
SOLOTVYNSKA there are supposedly forbidden zones and ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ missile bases.  
the population of/  
In 1956 2 villages beyond YABLINKA have been completely removed. She does not re-  
member the names of the villages. A road for motor vehicles has also been constru-  
cted there. Before crossing into the forbidden zone trucks "of unusual shape and  
covered with canvass" stopped and drivers who came from the zone took over the ve-  
hicles ~~and~~. Drivers who brought these trucks turned back to Stanislav with empty  
trucks. (see sketch)

2. Another similar forbidden zone with missile bases is supposedly in  
another part of the Carpathian Mountains called CHORNOHORA, particularly in a  
triangle South of the village ZHABIE./BURKUT/.

In 1956 the people of STANISLAV talked about the construction of these  
bases .

3. The use of the narrow gauge railroad from NADVIRNA to RAFAILOVA is  
forbidden for the civilian population and for tourists. The people are required  
to get a special pass from the Oblast Militia in Stanislav to travel on this rail-  
road.
