Aged 25, communist, member of Bulgarian delegation. Little Martha met him on 1 Aug 1962 at Kultur-House. He was interested in life in the States, and in particular in students. Told Little Martha that the Bulgarian Delegation to Helsinki consisted of 350 people, i.e. half of the Delegation to Vienna in 1958. Gave Little Martha "Youth of Bulgaria" and "La Securite Soviale en Republique Populaire de Bulgarie". Martha reciprocated with "Myth and Reality".

Subject told Little Martha that he came to Helsinki with Iraqi delegation without knowledge of Iranian authorities. He would have probably trouble should Iranian government get cognizant of his participation in the Festival.

Subject is dissatisfied with American aid to Iran because this is an aid to Shah and his family plus entourage. What Iran needs is democratic order, social reforms, and a government without Shah. But if this is impossible then he prefers communism to present system.

Little Martha gave him "Myth and Reality".
