SUBJECT: TSURKAN, Valeriyin

According to our Source on 7 June 1963 TSURKAN approached Prof Dr Yuri SHUMOVSKY of New York, the observer-correspondent of the Ukrainian Congress Committee at the UN, and proposed to him to start "a talk" on the subject of eventual normalization of relations and co-operation between the emigration and the Soviet Ukraine, represented by the Permanent Mission of the Ukrainian SSR. TSURKAN wanted first to discuss this problem with SHUMOVSKY himself but the latter suggested that he should contact directly someone at the UCC. TSURKAN should have answered that he would prefer to talk first privately with more interesting people who might have more understanding of the problem than the others.

Dr SHUMOVSKY informed his colleagues at the UCC about his meeting with TSURKAN and some of them were simply afraid of any eventual "talks" with the representative of the Ukrainian Mission.
