SUBJECT: Yurij KOSSACH

1. Reference is made to your memorandum dated 24 May 1963, your file No. 105-16481, concerning Subject. Please see our CSCI-3/776,573 in which information is given regarding Subject's recent contact with Mykola LEBED.

2. Information similar to that contained in your memorandum of 24 May was reported to us as follows: On 3 May 1963, just two days following Subject's meeting with Mr. LEBED, Vsevolod HOLUBNYCHY (Home address: 420 Riverside Drive, New York 25, New York) chanced to meet with Myroslava TAMORUG (who is not a source of this Agency but is a contact of Mr. LEBED's) and mentioned to her that he had heard Subject was planning to visit the Soviet Union and that rumors to the effect that he (Subject) was working for the FBI could be very harmful to him when he is in the Soviet Union. There was no other conversation about Subject which could have led to Mr. HOLUBNYCHY's remark about him and it is not known why the remark was made.

3. This Agency has no operational interest in Subject.


